# February Recipe

## Parmesan Incrusted Fish

### Ingredients:

**\* My preferred ingredients**

**Four Tilapia fillets (cod, crappie, catfish, flounder, or halibut may also be used)**

**½ teaspoon-crushed red pepper flakes (to taste)**

**½ to ¾ cup parmesan cheese**

**¼-cup regular or \*Dijon Mustard**

**½ to ¾ Tablespoon Tabasco or \*Sriracha sauce (Rooster sauce) to taste**

**1 ½ to 2 cups plain breadcrumbs**

**Olive oil**

**Rinse fillets and pat dry. In one flat dish, mix the dry ingredients (breadcrumbs, cheese, and red pepper flakes). In second flat dish mix mustard and Tabasco or rooster sauce. Use only enough of this mixture to lightly coat the fillets.**

**Lightly coat fillets with mustard mix and then coat with dry season mix.**

**Heat olive oil in skillet. Use only enough to cover the bottom of the fish. Don't get olive oil too hot or the fish will burn.**

**Place fillets in oil and fry slowly; flip once to ensure the fish is thoroughly cooked. Remove from oil and place on paper towels to absorb any remaining oil.**

**This mixture also works well on sliced eggplant.**
